

## **RESET Prayer Guide**

***Are you ready to RESET?*** We want you to be spiritually ready for the GREAT and AWESOME work that we (Andy & Jeremy) are expecting to see take place next week during our RESET services as well as the rest of 2019. We truly believe that this is the year that many of us will reconnect with our mighty God and hit the RESET button in our relationship with Him and others. In order to make certain that you are spiritually prepared we are calling the EHBC family to a week of intentional prayer and communion with the Lord God.

The following is a seven day prayer guide that provides a daily Scripture upon which to meditate as well as a daily prayer & spiritual focus to help drive our individual and corporate prayers as we get ready for the RESET next week. We are also asking those who would like to join with us to spend time praying and fasting this week.

We are asking for those who are able to fast during their lunch time each day and to spend that time praying and meditating through the following prayer guide. In addition, we are asking for those who would be willing to fast all day on Friday of this week as well as the Saturday prayer walking ministry and the entire RESET event in a dedicated and focused season (day) of prayer. Will you join us as we prepare for the revival that we are asking God to do in our own lives?

### **Monday, January 21**

**Scripture:** Psalm 100

**Focus:** Thanksgiving & Praise

Spend time today praising the goodness and faithfulness of God; spend time thanking Him for the many blessings and good gifts He has given you. Take a moment to list these blessings and gifts; take a moment to list the ways in which God has been faithful and good to you. Use the list you've created above to focus on how good God has been to you and what He might be calling you to do during this RESET event. Do you believe He desires for you to be in His Word? Do you believe He desires to have a growing relationship with you through prayer?

### **Tuesday, January 22**

**Scripture:** Psalm 23

**Focus:** The GOOD Shepherd

Today we want to focus on Jesus. Spend your prayer time today focusing upon the love that God has for you & the love that Jesus demonstrated for you. God gave His most precious and most valuable belonging – His Son. Jesus gave 100% of Himself for your redemption: He left the glories of Heaven and constant community with His heavenly Father; He lived amongst a people who despised and rejected Him; He died a painful and physical death; but more significantly, He paid your sin debt as He bore the full and unmitigated wrath of God's hatred and anger toward sin. He who never disobeyed or sinned became sin as He bore the weight of your punishment. The irony of all of this is that we call this "the Good News." It was NOT good for Jesus but it is GREAT news for us – the Gospel! In your prayer time today, meditate upon the actions of God and of His Christ. Evaluate your relationship with Jesus. Is it where you want it to be? Do you truly love Him more than anything and everything else? How is your love for Him being revealed in your daily relationship with Him? Are you spending time with Him in His Word, in prayer, in community, and/or in serving? What will you do to prepare to RESET your life in His will this week, next week, and in the weeks to come? Do you recognize the voice of the Shepherd?

### **Wednesday, January 23**

**Scripture:** Psalm 92

**Focus:** The Spiritual Needs of our Community

Spend time today praying for (1) your church family – pray for their spiritual relationship and maturity; pray for their marriage & family relationships; pray for their children and godly parenting; pray for the ability to know the will of God, to hear His voice, to read His Word, and to serve in His mission. (2) Pray for our community and county – pray for the lost (especially those you know personally, and pray for them by name), pray for God’s light to shine in Ohio County through His Church and especially pray for how EHBC can better impact our community; pray for those who will be coming to RESET next week that they will be transformed as they encounter Jesus. (3) Spend time praying for your family: your spouse, your marriage, your children; pray for God’s plan in your family to be made clear to you.

### **Thursday, January 24**

**Scripture:** Psalm 93

**Focus:** Dr. Larry Purcell (RESET speaker)

Spend time praying for our speaker next week, Dr. Larry Purcell. Pray for his health, pray for his schedule, pray for NO distractions in his life over the next few weeks, pray for his family, pray for his preparation and study time, pray for clarity in His thoughts as he prepares the messages that God has in store for EHBC and Ohio County. Pray that the Spirit of God will empower him to boldly proclaim the Good News of the Gospel.

### **Friday, January 25**

**Scripture:** Psalm 95

**Focus:** Worship Team and Volunteers

Focus today on the many different aspects of service and those serving during the RESET event. Pray for our worship team & music, for our volunteers in the nursery, childcare, parking lot, greeters, ushers, cleanup, counselors, and hospitality. Pray that our acts of service will be acts of love – love for God and love for one another.

### **Saturday, January 26**

**Scripture:** Psalm 130

**Focus:** Redemption & the Lost

Spend time today praying for the efforts of our Prayer Walking in Hartford & the OC. Pray for those who need to encounter Jesus to come to RESET. Pray for the lost in your family, your lost friends, & those who are lost in the community. Pray that they will hear the Word of God and be convicted of their sin (disobedience) and will repent, return, and RESET their lives in Christ.

### **Sunday, January 27**

**Scripture:** Psalm 117

**Focus:** Praise God for what He is going to do – in your life and in our community

Simply pray with expectation today for the GREAT work that God is going to do in your life, your family’s life, and this community as we humbly submit ourselves in obedience. Praise Him for the lives that will be changed, the relationships that will be restored, and those who will experience new life in Christ due to our faithful obedience. Just spend time praising Him today.
