QUESTIONS/DISCUSSION:

1. Are you part of the 20% who are involved, active, and serving at EHBC or are you in the 80% who are NOT serving faithfully? What is keeping you from being more involved?

[Answers will vary. Encourage group members to really unpack the “things” and “obstacles” that may be keeping them from fully engaging in life at EHBC. This life includes all aspects of the 4Ls – BIG church gatherings, small group gatherings, learning, serving in church and in the community, leadership positions, using their God given talents, gifts, skills, etc., financial commitment (tithing & generous giving), etc.]

2. How would you like to be remembered when it comes to the work and ministry of EHBC? What “list” would you like your name to be attached to for future generations to know about your faithfulness? What ministry or work or service?

[Piggy back off the lists found in chapters 11 and 12 of Nehemiah. What ministries and/or acts would they want to be remembered for – encourage detailed answers – chase a few of them down and see what would be necessary for that to happen]

3. What area(s) of your life needs to be dedicated or re-dedicated to the faithful service and stewardship of God’s calling, mission, and vision?

[Answers could include: marriage, parenting, occupation, finances, hobbies, health, church, etc., Attempt to drive this conversation to the more holistic approach to understanding that God desires to have our obedience and submission in all things, 24/7 – that there really are no divisions between our spiritual life and the other parts of our lives.]
