Discussion Questions

- 1) How are you challenged by Psalm 90:12? How would we “number our days carefully”?
- 2) Paul is challenging the self-autonomy of the Corinthian church in 1 Corinthians 10:23-24. How does attitude Paul is confronting here affect the different aspects of our lives (ie. Jobs, marriages, parenting, serving others, spending money...)?
- 3) Jesus said “it is more blessed to give than to receive.” A similar idea might be “it is better to serve than to be served.” It sounds good, but why is that so hard for us to really live out? What are the factors in ourselves and in the world around us that make it difficult to serve?
- 4) What does it mean to “do all things for the glory of Christ?” How is that different than the way you are living?
